A Big House Filled with Light for Everyone

Many people would like to have a very spacious house, full of light, with big windows and lots of room to entertain guests; it is possibly a dream for most of us. We all have a mental image of the house of our dreams, where we are totally happy. Perhaps today we are invited to consider the possibility of that house not being a physical place, but rather the home we make within ourselves: a wide place, full of light, with the transparency of truth and with freedom and hospitality for all—our own family and persons of every culture and language. If we dream this way, we are really dreaming of the house Jesus promised to prepare for us: God's house. It is a house with many rooms, a house of light, hospitality, and salvation. What is the way to that house of our dreams and our thirst? Jesus is clear: I am the way. What does that mean for us? What is the way of Jesus? The way of Jesus is the way of a holy people that we are told today we are. A holy people walks in dignity: its own dignity and respecting the dignity of the others. A holy people walk knowing that they are the beloved children of God; and, thus, live in truth, justice, and respect for the dignity and rights of the others. Those who walk accordingly are already building within themselves a spacious and welcoming house, full of light for everyone.

This people who walk as chosen people, royal priest, and prophet are a people who do not close their hearts or doors to different cultures. As we read in today's first reading, sometimes divisions arise almost spontaneously because of language, thinking, traditions, or cultural differences. But the holy Christian people know that they are united in Christ, who is the Way, the Truth and the Life. This holy people seek to create a spacious and welcoming home for all in the unity of faith.

As immigrants we know well that this earth is not our true home. We are on our way to a more lasting one: the dwelling of God; but while we walk, we reflect in our life what this dwelling of God means. It is a place of light, truth and justice; a place where all, without discrimination or distinction, have their home.

For Reflection

Are there divisions in your community that are making it difficult to share life among the various groups? How are they resolved? How do you build within yourself and in your family and community, that spacious and luminous place for all?

A muchas personas les gustaría tener una casa amplia, luminosa, con grandes ventanas y mucho espacio para invitar a amigos; tal vez todos quisiéramos eso. Todos tenemos una imagen de la casa de nuestros sueños, en donde seríamos totalmente felices. Quizá hoy se nos invite a pensar que esa casa es posible que no sea un lugar físico sino el hogar que hacemos dentro de nosotros: un lugar amplio y luminoso, con la transparencia de la verdad y la libertad y cabida para todos —nuestra propia familia y personas de toda cultura y lenguaje—. Vamos hacia otro más duradero: la morada de Dios; pero mientras caminamos, vamos reflejando en nuestra vida lo que significa esa morada de Dios; un lugar de luz, verdad y justicia; un lugar donde todos, sin discriminación ni distinción, tienen su hogar.

El Rincón de Raquel
