God Gives Everything Out of Love

We invest greatly in our children, in our family, and in our future. We want to give the best of ourselves and there is no sacrifice big enough, no effort that cannot be undertaken, nor work too strenuous for us. As long as we can attain the goal of achieving a better future, nothing else matters. In seeking a better life many of us endure dangers, anguishes, and problems. So when things don't turn out well, we become frustrated and disillusioned.

Depression can lead us to throw in the towel, give up on doing anything else or seeking other paths. Sometimes our efforts are met with a lack of gratitude, misunderstanding or indifference by the same people they are supposed to benefit. Even if we don't do things so that people can appreciate them, the lack of gratitude can hurt greatly; but, being mistreated by those whom we have treated well can be an even greater source of pain than the lack of appreciation.

It is not difficult to imagine, therefore, the immensity of God's pain. He has invested immensely into our vineyard. He loved it so much that he sent his own son. It is easy to imagine God's frustration in seeing that not only has the vineyard failed to bear fruit, but his son was rejected. We can imagine the feelings of disillusionment, sadness, and disbelief after having devoted so much of him. God does not give materials things; he gives himself; and, apparently, it may seem for nothing.

The good thing with God is that he is capable of finding a reason to forgive and continue waiting even if it seems impossible. He always has a reason to continue loving even when it appears that his efforts are useless. Since he does not force anyone, instead he gives freedom, God cannot obligate anyone to bear fruit. He only invites. The image of God giving everything out of love for his vineyard, that is, us, should be sufficient to move us deeply and encourage us to fight, and respond to the God of love who gives everything.

For Reflection

In what ways have I wasted some of the gifts that God has given me without bearing any fruit? Have there been times when I have rejected the love of God in my life?

Healing Mass – Thurs., Oct. 12th – 6pm

Who may receive the Sacrament:

Canon 998

The anointing of the sick by which the Church commends to the suffering and glorified Lord the faithful who are dangerously sick so that He relieve and save them, is conferred by anointing them with oil and using the words prescribed in the liturgical books.

Canon 1004

1. The anointing of the sick can be administered to a member of the faithful who, after having reached the use of reason, begins to be in danger due to sickness or old age.

2. This sacrament can be repeated whenever the sick person again falls into a serious sickness after convalescence or whenever a more serious crisis develops during the same sickness.

These canons can be summarized as follows. Those who satisfy three conditions may be anointed:

1) A baptized Catholic, 2) Reached the age of reason, 3) Begun to be in danger from illness or the infirmities of age, or have become sick again or underwent a further crisis. It should be noted that the danger need only have begun to exist. The person does not have to be "in extremis" (in imminent danger of dying). This is a change from the pastoral practice before the Second Vatican Council.

The ritual gives the following examples: "those who are dangerously ill through sickness or old age", "a sick person...before surgery whenever the surgery is necessitated by a dangerous illness", "elderly people...if they are weak, though not dangerously ill", "sick children...sufficiently mature to be comforted by the sacrament", "sick people who have lost consciousness or who have lost the use of reason...if...they would have requested it if they had been in possession of their faculties".

Siempre tiene un motivo para seguir amando aunque sus esfuerzos parezcan inútiles. Como no forza a nadie, sino que da la libertad, Dios no puede obligar a nadie a dar fruto. Solo invita. La imagen de Dios entregándolo todo por amor a su viña, es decir, a nosotros, debería ser suficiente para conmovernos profundamente y animarnos a luchar y responder a ese Dios de amor que nos lo da todo.

Misa de Sanación – Jueves 12 de octubre - 6pm

Quien puede recibir el Sacramento: Derecho Canónico 998

La unción de los enfermos por la cual la Iglesia encomienda al Señor sufriente y glorificado a los fieles que están peligrosamente enfermos para que los alivie y salve, se les confiere ungiéndolos con aceite y usando las palabras prescritas en los libros litúrgicos.

Canon 1004

1. La unción al enfermo puede ser suministrada a un miembro de los fieles que, después de haber alcanzado uso de razón, empieza a estar en peligro debido a enfermedad o edad avanzada.

2. Este sacramento puede ser repetido siempre que la persona enferma otra vez caiga en una enfermedad seria

después de la convalecencia o siempre que una crisis más seria se desarrolle durante la misma enfermedad. Estos Derechos canónicos se pueden resumir como sigue: estos que satisfacen tres condiciones pueden ser ungidos:

1) Un Católico Bautizado. 2) Tiene la edad de uso de razón. 3) Empezó a estar en peligro de muerte o la debilidad por la edad, o se han enfermado de nuevo o han sufrido una crisis posterior. Hay que señalar que el peligro solo ha empezado a existir. La persona no tiene que estar “en extremado” (peligro inminente de morir). Esto es un cambio de la práctica pastoral antes del Concilio Vaticano II.

El ritual da los siguientes ejemplos: “Los que están peligrosamente enfermos por enfermedad o vejez”, “una persona enferma...antes de cirugía siempre que la cirugía es necesitada por una enfermedad peligrosa”. “personas de edad avanzada” si están débiles, no por enfermedades peligrosas”. Niños enfermos...suficientemente maduros para ser confortados por el sacramento”. “Personas enfermas que han perdido la conciencia o que han perdido el uso de razón...si...lo hubieran solicitado, si han estado en posesión de sus facultades”.
